Qualification Overview: This qualification is aimed at those who wish to become a Paediatric First Aider in the workplace with a responsibility for the welfare of infants and children. This qualification is intended for learners already working or preparing to work in industry.

Learners gaining this qualification will know that First Aid is the responsibility of everyone involved in the working environment. Its topics are regarded by the Early Years Foundation Stage as being important to maintaining good practice in the safe, prompt and effective treatment of injuries and ill health of infants and children who are under the care of trained personnel.

Entry Guidance: There are no prerequisites for this qualification. It is advised that learners have a minimum of Level 1 in literacy or numeracy or equivalent. Cohorts are to be no larger than 12 learners per Nominated Tutor. This qualification is approved for delivery to the age ranges pre-16, 16-18 and 19+.

Progression and further learning routes include:

- Level 3 Award in 3-day First Aid at Work qualification.
- Level 2 Award in Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation and Automated External Defibrillation.
